**Does your private well require reconstruction? Do you have an abandoned private well?** Cost-sharing grants are available to assist with the expense of properly reconstructing and/or plugging abandoned private wells (including cisterns that present a contamination risk to groundwater). Bacteria, arsenic, nitrate, and manure may lurk in your water, creating unsafe levels of contamination. In most cases, laboratory testing is the only way to thoroughly check the safety of your well water.

**If you haven't tested your well recently, you may be drinking harmful man-made and natural pollutants and not even know it.** FREE well water testing is available.

**Black Hawk County Health Department wants you to be safe. That's why we're offering up to 100% cost-sharing grants for well reconstruction/plugging and FREE well water sample collection and testing.** Hurry! Short-term grants are available—first come, first serve through June 30.
