## **Free Public H1N1 Clinics Every Friday**

Free H1N1 Flu Shot Clinics will be open at the Black Hawk County Health Department every Friday from 9am to 3pm through the month of February. These are offered at no cost and open to everyone regardless of age or health conditions. Clinics will be at the Health Department which is on the 5<sup>th</sup> Floor of the Pinecrest Building, 1407 Independence Avenue in Waterloo. In addition, the Health Department is going to all county schools in February to offer the second dose of H1N1 flu vaccine to children 9 and under who still need it.
