

Black Hawk Park

Black Hawk Park was the first park acquired by the Black Hawk County Conservation Board and is named after Chief Black Hawk of the Sauk Indian tribe. Today the park's 1,490 acres form a greenbelt along the Cedar River from Cedar Falls to Washington Union Bridge, four miles north.

Activities

Camping: Available on a first come basis.

- \$13 per night
- \$17 with electric
- \$22 with full hook-up

Cedar Campground:

142 electric hookup sites

Fogdall Campground:

- 13 electric only sites
- 21 full hookup sites

Amenities: Elevated shower house, pit toilets, horseshoe pitching court, playgrounds, seasonal camp hosts.

Cabins: Red Oak & Maple cabins are \$35/night plus tax. Cabins offer 2 bunk beds, dinette that converts to a double bed, microwave, dorm size frig, hot plate, cold water sink, air conditioning & a patio with picnic table. Located next to elevated shower house.

Trails: Black Hawk Park is connected to the Cedar Valley Trails 90+ miles of trails throughout the Cedar Valley. Trail maps are available from Rangers and brochure racks.

Fishing: Access to Cedar River, Snag Creek & 5 ponds in Black Hawk Park.

Boat Ramps: Located across from archery range and at Washington Union Access (northwest side of C57 bridge).

Public Hunting: See map on reverse for areas open to hunting in Black Hawk Park, Beaver Creek Access, Railroad Lake Access & Rotary Reserve. Please respect private property.

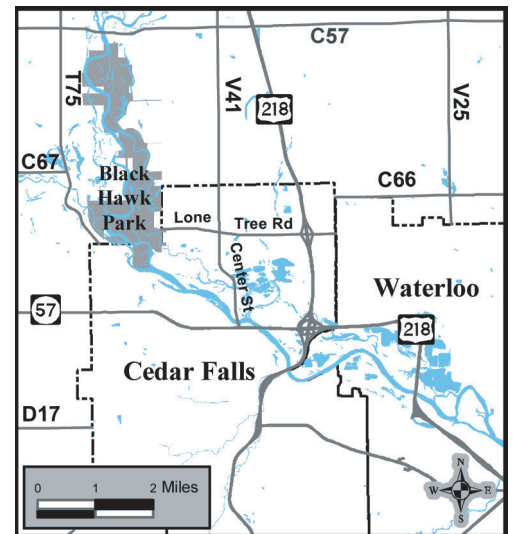
Reservations can be made for Cabins and Shelters by calling 319-433-7275 or visit www.blackhawkcountyparks.com.
