

# Hickory Hills Park

This area includes the unusual geologic feature, Casey's Paha, dedicated as a State Preserve in 1989. The 723 acre park offers camping, basketball, picnicking, sand volleyball, disc golf, hiking, fishing, cross-country skiing, and sledding.

## Activities

**Camping:** A large camping area is surrounded by 82 RV sites, 27 of which are full hookup sites. Electricity is available at each RV site and community water hydrants are scattered throughout the area. Showers, flush toilets, and a dump station are provided in season. The group camp area will accommodate up to 20 RVs and/or numerous tents. Electricity and pit toilets are provided.

**Cabins:** Three rustic cabins offer 2 bunk beds, cold water sink, microwave, table and chairs, refrigerator, hotplate and air conditioning. Four all-season cabins are handicap accessible and larger with one double bed and two bunk beds, a couch and TV/DVD player, a bathroom with a shower, a kitchen with a stove, microwave, sink and refrigerator and include hot water, heating and air conditioning. All cabins accommodate six people.

**Fees:** Walk in camping: \$13, \$17 with electric, \$22 for full hookup. Cabins: rustic \$35 plus tax and all-season \$66-94 per night plus tax.

**Lakeview Lodge:** Overlooking Casey Lake, this four season lodge is a perfect place for weddings and reunions. For further information call 319-433-7275 or see our website for the floorplan.

**Picnicking & Shelters:** Picnic facilities include tables, fire receptacles, toilets, and water. Ground fires are restricted to the fire rings. In the picnic area you will find courts for sand volleyball, basketball, and a disc golf course. The Archers Shelter accommodates 100, but can be expanded to serve 175. It has a dry kitchen with refrigerator, microwave, serving counter and stove. The Hickory Shelter is a large, rustic, double-sided shelter accommodating 75 to 100 people on each side. The Sunset Shelter accommodates 25 people.

**Public Hunting:** Public hunting is allowed on the west 175 acres of the park. Regulations prohibit the use of rifles. Other regulations and information are posted at the Archer's Shelter parking, near the west end of the lake.

*Snowmobiles, ATV's and horseback riding is not allowed.*

**Casey Lake:** The 39 acre lake is one of Northeast Iowa's premiere largemouth bass hot spots and also holds channel catfish, crappies and bluegill. A number of small ponds provide quiet fishing away from the lake. Motor boat use is restricted to electric motor only. Kayaks, canoes and paddle boats are welcome. All state laws apply.

**Trails:** Several miles of hiking trails offer park users a chance to witness nature's endless variety.

**Wildlife Exhibit:** Numerous species representing Iowa's wildlife heritage can be observed in our pens which provide a natural setting for viewing the animals. The display usually includes bison, elk, white-tail deer, turkeys, and upland game birds but is subject to change.

**Special Events:** Registered campers are welcome to join us for Halloween weekend which includes campsite decoration, pumpkin carving, and costume contests. Check our website for updates.
